What We Do

- Repair and rehabilitate the homes of low-income homeowners in Baltimore City and Baltimore County.
- We work in one neighborhood in Baltimore City and one neighborhood in Baltimore County each year.
- In addition to repairing dozens of homes in each location, we also implement at least one community beautification project in each neighborhood.
- Our Rebuilding Day is the last Saturday of each April. Most of our work is done on this day.
- We have recently expanded and now provide year-round services through our Fix-It Program.

Eligibility for Our Services

- Be a homeowner (Either paying a mortgage or owning outright).
- Must meet income guidelines
- Be over the age of 60, have a disability, or have children living in the house.

How to Get Involved

- Volunteer on Rebuilding Day or with the Fix-It Program.
- Organize a team of volunteers.
- If you are a skilled tradesperson, donate your time.
- Volunteer year-round as a board member or committee member.
- Make a monetary donation or ask your company or place of worship to make a donation
