Driving Directions from I-695 (coming from the North)

Exit 39, Merritt Blvd
Proceed on Merritt Blvd. to stop sign at the end of the road.
Turn left onto Sollers Point Road and continue approximately 1.5 miles to Main Street.
Turn left on Main Street and continue 2 to 3 blocks.
At the fork, bear to the left onto New Pittsburg Avenue and follow the road around to the Senior Center.
The Senior Center will be on the right side of the road.

Driving Directions Coming from the Key Bridge on I-695

Exit 44 to Dundalk Avenue.
Make right onto Dundalk Avenue.
Right on Main Street to Senior Center.

Driving Directions from downtown Baltimore:

Take CHARLES STREET North past Johns Hopkins Homewood Campus
Cross 33rd Street and University Parkway
About ¼-mile after you cross University Parkway, turn RIGHT on 39TH STREET
After about ½-mile, you will cross over Greenmount Avenue
Turn LEFT onto OLD YORK ROAD at the next traffic light
3921 is a pale yellow building on the right.
Parking is available on the Street along Old York Road

Driving Directions from I-83:

Take the COLD SPRING LANE exit (exit #9) going EAST
Go approx 2 miles and turn RIGHT on YORK ROAD
Go approx ¾-mile and turn LEFT onto 39TH STREET
Turn LEFT onto OLD YORK ROAD at the next traffic light
3921 is a pale yellow building on the right.
Parking is available on the Street along Old York Road

Please note that OLD YORK ROAD is a one-way street.
