**1) Please check the space next to the level of difficulty your group will be able to work on. The descriptions below are what we use to rate the difficulty of each house:**

**\_\_\_ Light--Simple tasks that can be done by mostly unskilled volunteers.** For example: painting, cleaning, caulking, drywall patching, installation of smoke detector/carbon monoxide detector/fire extinguisher, doorknob replacement, removing debris, securing loose rugs, interior handrail installation, hanging simple shelves, very minor plumbing or electrical, lever handles for faucets or doorknobs, shower head replacement, general landscaping.

**\_\_\_ Medium--Needs a knowledgeable House Captain. Might require some prep work (not more than one day) by a small crew.** May require many of the tasks in the "Light" category but also requires more skilled work. For example: interior door replacement, working with interior doors or door frames, skilled carpentry, sink/faucet replacement, toilet repair/replacement, replacing light fixtures or electrical sockets, laying down floor tiles or carpet, bathroom vanity installation, stair repair, landscaping related to drainage issues.

**\_\_\_ Heavy--Needs a very knowledgeable House Captain. Will definitely require at least one day of prep work, possibly more.** May require many of the tasks in the "Light" and "Medium" categories but also requires very skilled and labor intensive work. For example: major electrical or plumbing work, substantial carpentry such as building walls or rebuilding stairs/porches/decks, window replacement, wheelchair ramp-building, conversion of bathroom to handicapped accessible, grab bar installation, exterior door replacement, installing exterior handrails, structural floor repair, pouring cement.
